

# Haiti Mission Team Adopts a Family

The Haiti mission trip was scheduled for June 2020. The trip was postponed because of Covid-19 and we were hopeful to do it this past summer. Haiti has been very politically unstable for the past 3 years and got even worse this summer. The President of Haiti was assassinated and there was a lot of violence and kidnappings in the capital city. We decided it was not safe to travel to Haiti, so we had to cancel the Haiti mission trip again.

We have an opportunity to help a family in Haiti who had their home destroyed by the earthquake. There were 13 people living in this home before the August 14th earthquake. Here is the information about those living there: Mother- Ytelene Joseph, Father- Lessage Guerrier; they are living with 6 kids and 5 grandkids. The home is located in Les Cayes, which was just west of the earthquake epicenter.

If you would like to join us in helping this family, you can write a check to the LPUMC and write Haiti mission in the memo. It will cost around \$10,000 for this family to rebuild their home. We will be receiving updates and photos on the construction progress. Thank you already for all of you that supported our Haiti mission trip fundraisers in the past. We just sent \$2000 of the mission team money for them to get started. The Harris Church has taken an offering for this family and will be giving mission money to help as well. We hope and pray that this money blesses this family and gives them a safe place to live.
