Evening Circle

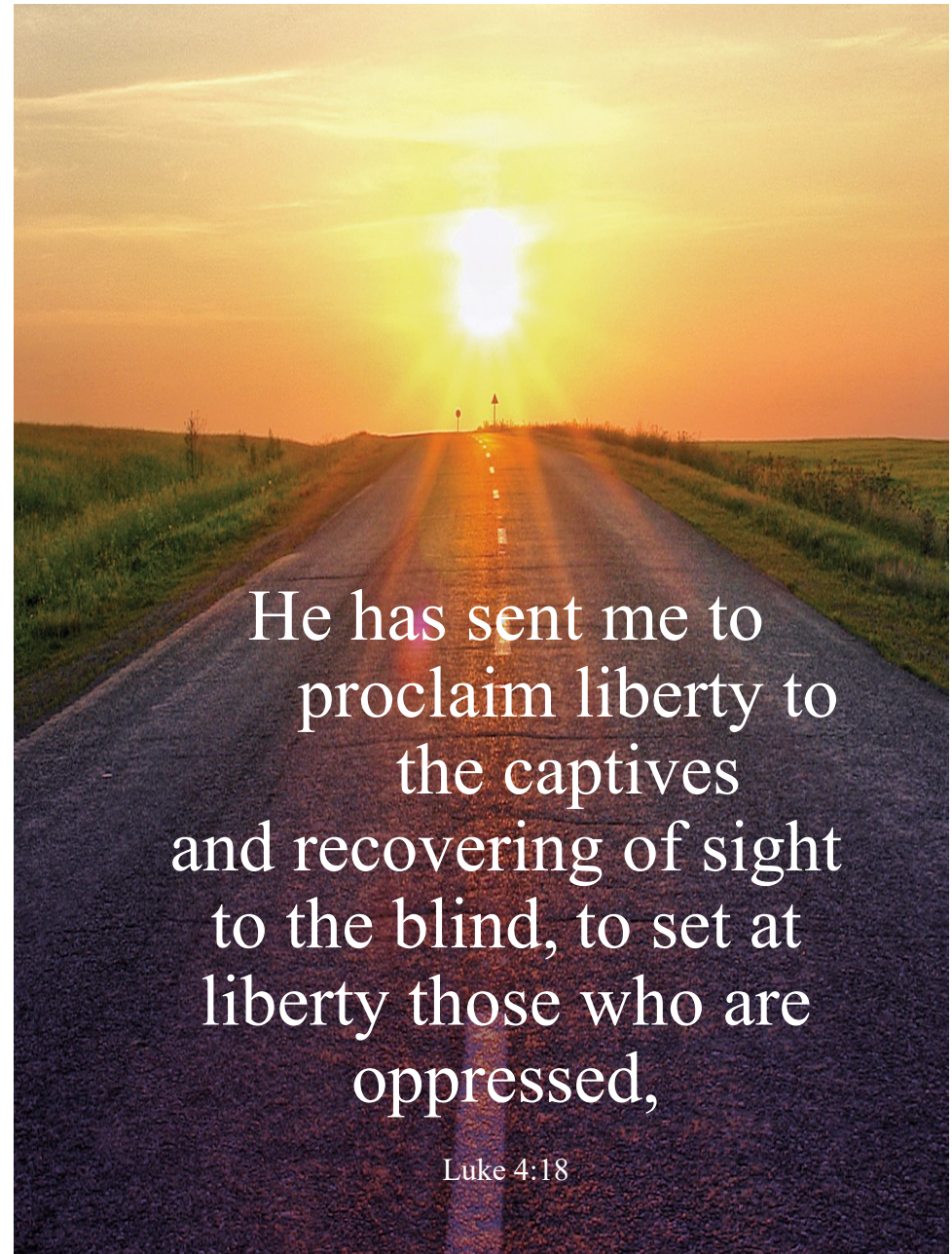
