


Suggested items for Lake Park Food Bank

Canned meats – chicken or tuna

Baking mix / pancake mix that you just add water

Creamed soups – cream of celery, cream of chicken, cream of mushroom

Canned soup or dry soup mixes

Canned fruit – peaches, pears, fruit cocktail, mandarin oranges

Pasta sauces – Ragu or Prego, Hunts, Alfredo sauce, tomato sauce

Pasta – spaghetti, macaroni

Drink mixes – Kool-Aid, lemonade, iced tea

Dry cereal – Any kind

Condiments – ketchup, mustard, salad dressing, mayonnaise

Pudding cups or fruit cups



There will be a congregational vote to determine if the Harris Church will disaffiliate from the United Methodist Church on Thursday, June 22, 2023, at 7:15 pm, at the Harris Church. This vote is according to the rules established by the United Methodist Church General Conference. Persons must be present to vote, 18 years old, and an official member of the Harris Church. A ²/₃ affirmative vote to disaffiliate is required in order to pass.

Church members are invited to attend the Harris Ad Council meeting on Thursday, June 8, at 6:30 pm to learn more about the disaffiliation process. Disaffiliation updates will be announced in church. On June 4 and June 11 following the Harris church service, a few Ad Council members will be available to discuss the disaffiliation process and to try to answer any questions that members may have. LAKE PARK DISAFFILIATION PROCESS UPDATE

The official congregational vote to determine if the Lake Park Church will disaffiliate from the United Methodist Church has been scheduled at the church for June 22, 2023, at 6:00 p.m., as according to the rules established by the United Methodist Church General Conference. The votes can only be made by members of the church **present** at the time of the vote, and a 2/3 affirmative vote to disaffiliate is required in order to pass.

Disaffiliation Informational Discussion Groups are being formed to allow members of our congregation an opportunity to learn more, and ask questions, about the church disaffiliation issue and process prior to the scheduled June 22 special church conference vote. Sign-up sheets are being passed around for those that wish to attend one of these small group meetings, and they will be available on the table in the fellowship hall.
